Minutes of the Lake Oakland County Lake Improvement Board Meeting July 31, 2024

Rick Sabina called the meeting to order at 3:05 p.m. at the Oakland County Water Resources Commissioner's Office 1st Floor Meeting Room.

Rick Sabina reminded everyone to sign the attendance sheet (see Attachment 'A').

APPROVAL OF THE MEETING AGENDA:

Rick Sabina asked to make an addition to Item 8: Lake Oakland Invoice Ratifications. Item 8e will be the ratification of Goose Busters! Invoice #2020-MH-1355.544 for \$520.00.

OLD BUSINESS:

A. Project Work Journal

Jared Laughlin reviewed the project work journal dated July 30, 2024 (see Attachment 'C'). He shared that the current remaining budget for the year is \$14,030.00 minus the \$520.00 invoice from Goose Busters! He believes there will be enough for a late season harvest based on the \$8,200 needed last year. There might also be potential for another treatment in addition to a small harvest.

B. Herbicide Treatment

Jared Laughlin foresees a treatment for algae in the late summer or early fall. Next survey scheduled for August 15th. Water samples will also be collected.

C. Plant Harvesting

Rick Sabina mentioned that he has not been impressed with the latest plant harvesting efforts. His cove has a lot of wild celery and didn't see much improvement. Kimberly Markee also agrees that the plant harvesting has not been as successful this year. Kimberly Markee mentioned that we cannot compare the harvesting yields from year to year because the units of measurement are different between companies. Jared Laughlin will reach out to the vendors and make a correlation.

D. Goose Mitigation

Rick Sabina believes that roughly 30 nests were destroyed and around 120 eggs were removed.

NEW BUSINESS:

A. Priority Waste Hydraulic Fluid

A riparian reported that oil or hydraulic fluid was leaking from a Priority Waste vehicle, and he was concerned about it getting into the lake. Rick Sabina stated that the riparian didn't have any evidence or photos regarding the incident. Kimberly Markee mentioned that she can bring this to Priority Waste's attention in her daily discussions with them.

B. Review Harvest Reports

This item was already discussed in "Old Business."

PUBLIC COMMENTS:

Ryan Woloszyk, from Oakland County WRC, is the Lake Level Engineer and he came to give the Board and update on the dam for Lake Oakland. Lake Oakland has two dams, and the primary one has a bridge over it with a culvert that is going to fail. This winter, WRC is going to start working on the culvert to prevent it from collapsing. WRC is also in the process of updating all of the Emergency Management plans for the dams. These two activities have increased the assessment by roughly 30% (about \$40 to \$70/year). This is a separate line item on the winter tax bill, different from the Lake Board, and approved by the Board of Commissioners.

Michael Perzyk, resident, asked if there has been any monitoring around the fish levels in Lake Oakland. He is concerned with the number of people fishing along Dill Drive. Rick Sabina stated that the last report from DNR was done in 2021, and it showed a very healthy lake. DNR is tasked with sampling every lake in Michigan on a recurrence interval of 10-20 years. Jared Laughlin mentioned that private lakes sometimes choose to hire a consultant to monitor the health of their fish, but public lakes generally don't have the funds for this.

There was discussion about potential lily pad treatment in the fall for homeowners who may be interested in it.
